

OAK & SADDLE EQUINE EDUCATION *and* ACTIVITIES

We design lesson plans tailored to the needs of your group. We have provided programs for Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, Campfire, and American Heritage Girls in addition to the activities that we make available during the summer months for the various camps that are hosted at Tall Oaks. We invite you to participate in one of our established plans, or incorporate the equine experience into your own event.

Grades 2 & 3

We offer approximately a two hour program that includes a safety talk, horse “ed”, and a short trail walk. Attendants (usually provided by the group) may lead the horses for these youngsters. Maximum of 20 participants.

Grades 4 & 5

A three – four hour program; safety lesson, horse “ed”, and an independent ride in the arena through patterns & obstacles. Minimum of 4 participants/maximum 12.

Grades 6 & above

Time varies according to activity level; safety review, grooming & saddling horses, riding in the arena or on trails. Minimum of 4 participants/maximum 12.
